which they will study.

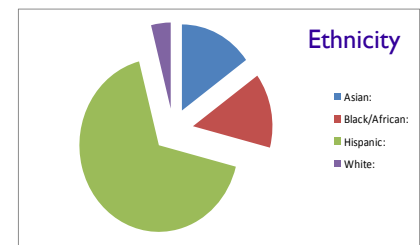
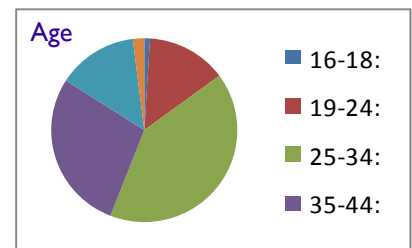
Curriculum is thematic in

- **ESL students demonstrated academic progress that met or exceeded the State Goals in 4 of 6 student performance levels.**
- **The neighborhood ESL programs demonstrated a student retention rate of 86%**
- **55% of ESL students completed less than the 9th grade.**
- **62% of students were women.**
